Department Reports to	Library Library Manager and/or other designated staff

Duties and Responsibilities

On a weekly basis, tag items in the library collection with RFID tags in preparation for self-check and inventory control using RFID technology.

Job Requirements

- Must be able to work independently.
- Must be accurate.
- Must be comfortable using computers.
- Involves some physical exertion such as standing long periods of time, recurring stooping and lifting objects weighing less than 25 lbs.

Time Requirement

Minimum of two hours a week for a minimum of three months.

Training Requirements

- \diamond Orientation to the library.
- Training on the 3M mobile conversion stations.

Reports to

Library Manager and/or other designated staff.

Minimum Training and Experience

Must be 14 years of age or older.
