Babies birth-15 months with an adult

Short rhymes, songs, finger plays and books introduce babies to the wonders of language. Parents will enjoy sharing familiar songs and learning new rhymes while sharing this time with their little ones. Siblings are welcome but must sit and participate for the safety of the babies.

Smart Start Storytime

Pre-K children ages 3-5, on their own 9:30 - 10:00 AM

Tuesdays, March 19 - April 30

This 30-minute program introduces children to classic picture books and fun stories. Finger rhymes, flannel boards, songs, action rhymes, and other related activities are designed to foster pre-reading skills. This program is intended for children to experience a group setting without an adult.
