

Museum Passes

Basketball Hall of Fame - Admits six (6) visitors daily at discounted prices (adults at \$14 each and children at \$9 each). 10% discount on any photo purchase at Hoopshots Photo Center.

Beardsley Zoo - Admits up to six (6) guests at \$5 admission each. Limited to 1 family per day.

The Children's Museum and Roaring Brook Nature Center

Children's Museum - Admits one (1) touring visitor with each paid admission, up to four (4) free admissions. Planetarium/laser shows require fees.

Roaring Brook - Admits one (1) touring visitor with each paid admission, up to four (4) free admissions.

Connecticut Historical Society Museum & Library - Admits two (2) adults and up to four (4) children to the museum galleries.

Connecticut River Museum - Admits two (2) adults and their children or grandchildren under Age 18.

Connecticut Trolley Museum - Admits two (2) adults and two (2) children to CT Trolley, Antique Fire Apparatus and Antique Bus Museums. Free trolley rides during operating season which begins in April. Additional charge for some special events. Discounts on gift shop merchandise.

Connecticut's Old State House - Admits two (2) adults and two (2) children for free during regular museum hours. Admission for after-hour events not covered. Garage parking tickets can be stamped for \$5/day parking. Pass courtesy of Connecticut's Old State House.

Eric Carle Museum of Picture Book Art - Admits two (2) adults and four (4) children.

Florence Griswold Museum - Admits two (2) adults and two (2) children under 12 years. Surcharge of \$5 per person over age 12 during museum's special fall event (whether visiting faerie houses or not); children age 12 and under admitted free, thanks to an anonymous grant.

Harriet Beecher Stowe Center - Admits two (2) visitors for a free tour of the center.

Hill-Stead Museum - Admits one (1) adult and two (2) children under age 18. Not valid for special programs and events.

Imagine Nation Museum - Admits up to six (6) visitors at half-price during regular museum hours. Not valid for special events or registered programs.

Lutz Children's Museum - Admits six (6) visitors to "Hands On" exhibits and live animal room.

Maritime Aquarium at Norwalk - Admits six (6) visitors at \$2 off each combination ticket (aquarium and daytime IMAX®) purchase.

Mark Twain House - Buy one (1) adult admission; get one (1) adult or two (2) children for no charge. One use, one discount per visit.

Mashantucket Pequot Museum and Research Center - Admits up to two (2) adults and two (2) children to permanent exhibits at \$5 off each.

Mystic Aquarium ~ Institute for Exploration - Admits four (4) visitors at \$5.00 off each. Pass courtesy of Mystic Aquarium.

Mystic Seaport ~ The Museum of America and the Sea™ - Admits two (2) adults and three (3) children (Age 17 and under) at 50% off regular admission pricing.

New Britain Museum of American Art - Admits four (4) general admission visitors. Additional fees may apply to special exhibitions, events and programs. Pass may not be used for docent-led tours. Children under age 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

New England Air Museum at Bradley International Airport - Admits up to five (5) visitors at 50% off of regular admission rates. Children ages 3 and under admitted free.

New Haven Museum - Admits four (4) visitors. Free on first Sundays each month (1-4 pm).

Norman Rockwell Museum - Admits two (2) adults at discounted rate of \$10 each. Children ages 18 and under admitted free.

Old Sturbridge Village - Admits up to four (4) visitors for half price during daytime hours. Does not include nighttime admission.

Peabody Museum of Natural History at Yale University - Admits four (4) visitors per visit at \$6 off each to museum galleries. Note: "Pay as you wish" admission on Thursdays from 2-5 pm, September through June.

State Parks and Forests - Admits two (2) adults and four (4) children ages 6-12 at state historical sites and exhibit centers at Dinosaur, Fort Trumbull and Gillette Castle State Parks. Cannot be used for camping or special events. Pass courtesy of the State of Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection.

Wadsworth Atheneum Museum of Art - Admits two (2) adults ages 18 and up to general exhibitions. Children and teens ages 17 and under admitted free. During Fine Art & Flowers and Festival of Trees & Traditions, additional fees apply. Note: Admission free for families on second Saturday each month if arrive before 1:00 p.m. Pass courtesy of Wadsworth Atheneum Museum of Art.

Museum passes listed in **red** are printable "on demand" from home or at the library.

Museum passes listed in **blue** must be checked out from and returned to the library; for these returnable passes, the standard museum pass loan rules apply:

- 2-day checkout
- return in person to the library's lending desk staff
- \$10/day late fee (max \$100) • \$100 for a lost pass.
