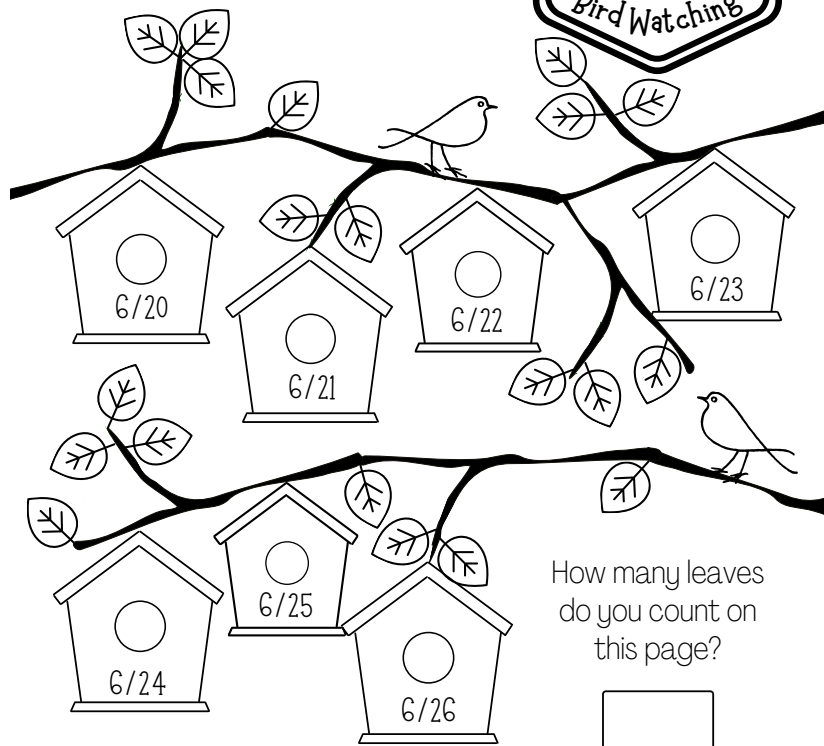

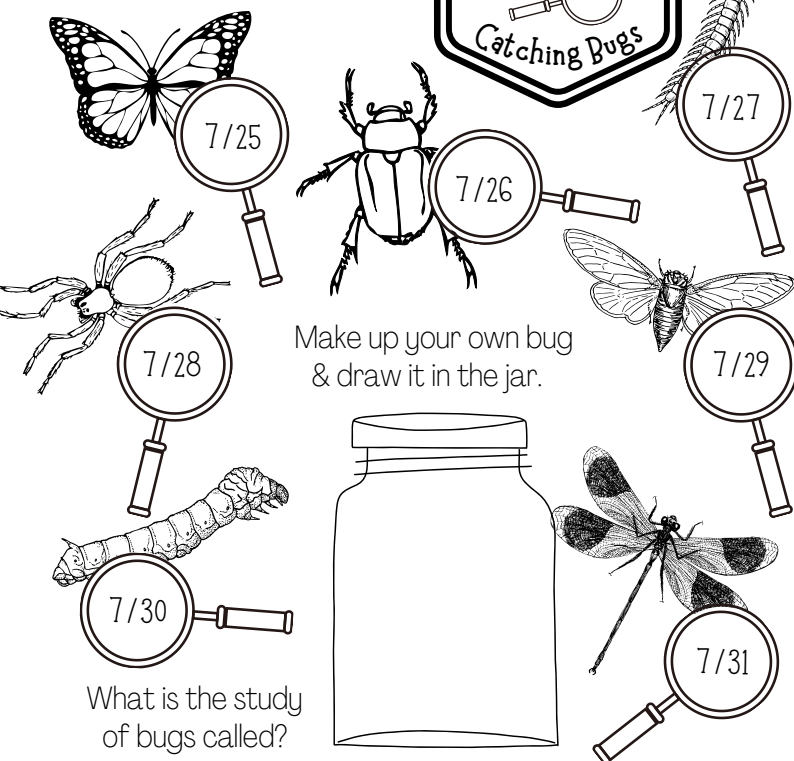

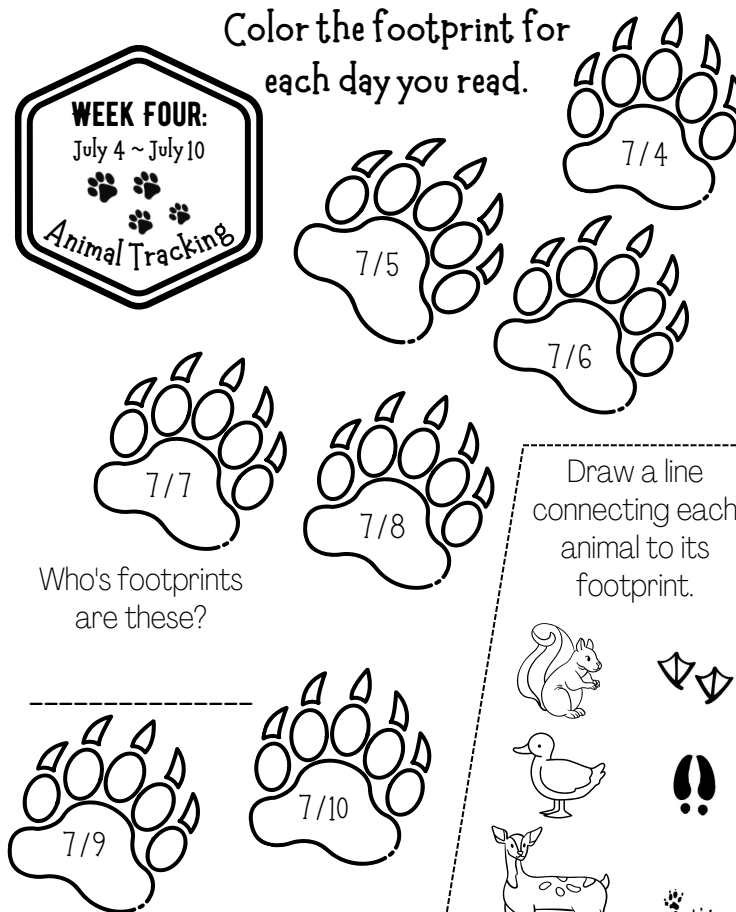

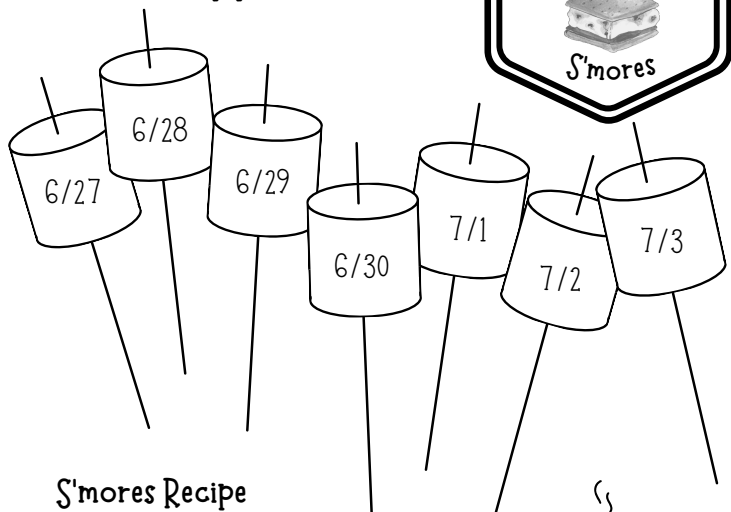

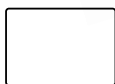

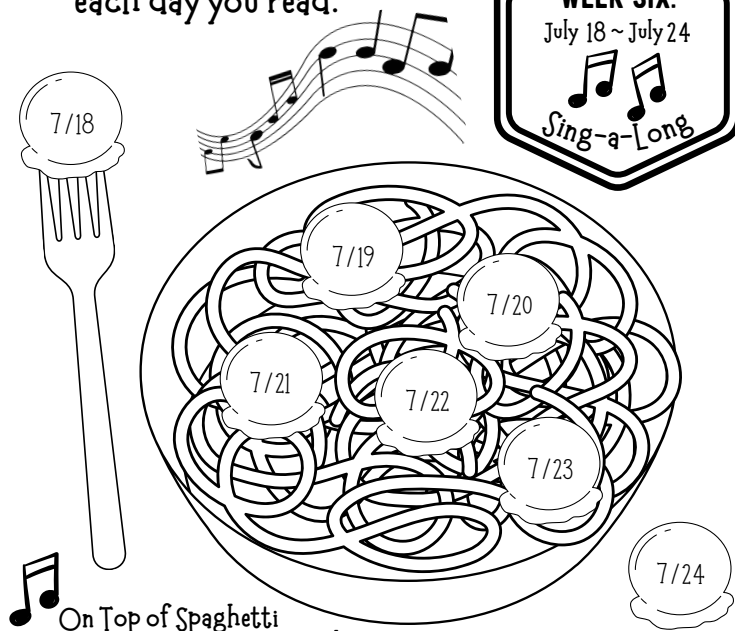


How Big is Your Fish?
