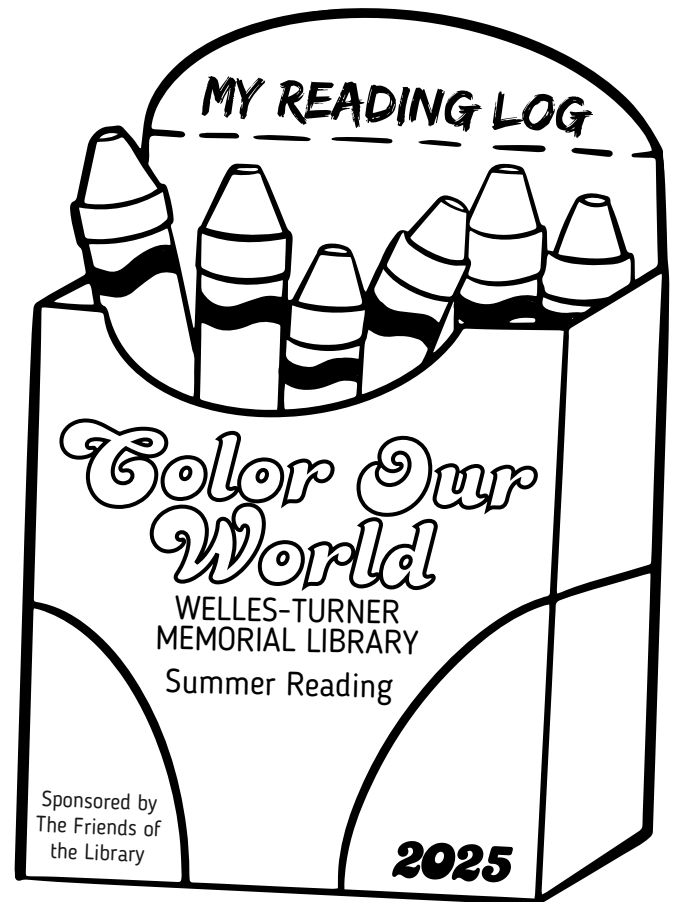

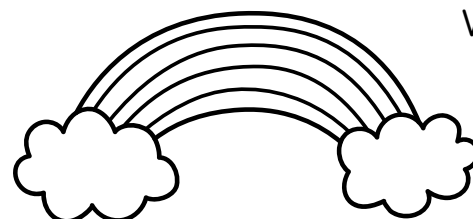
Bring your Reading Calendar to the Children's Department to register and receive your reward. The first reward is available on **June 23**.



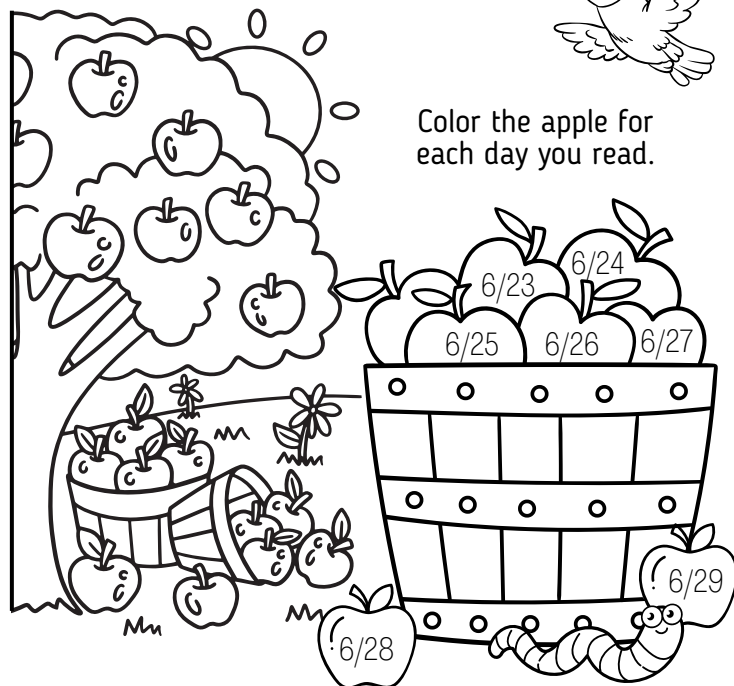

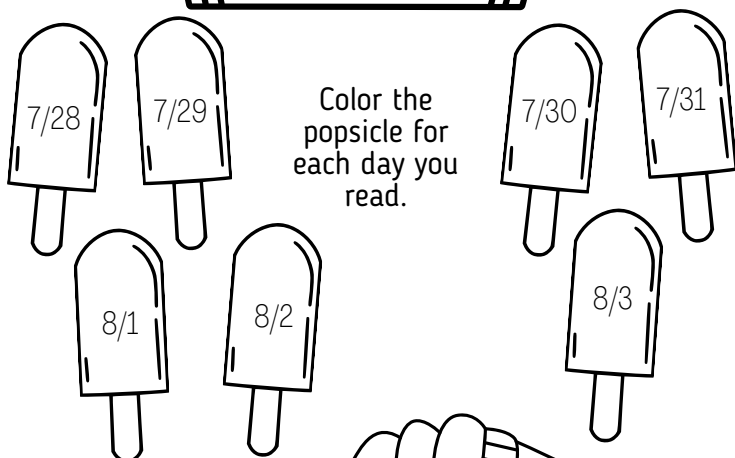


Color the apple for each day you read.

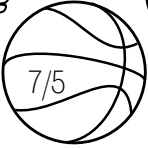

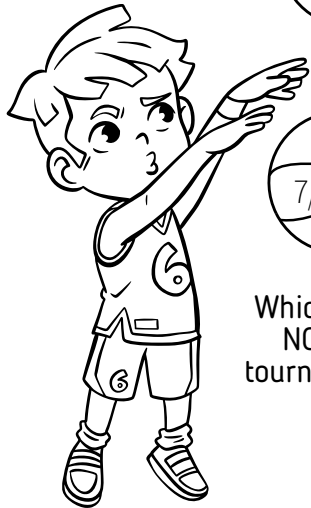

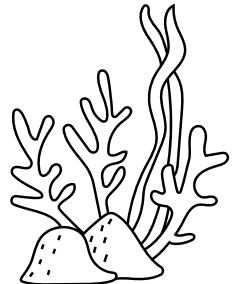


Color the jellyfish for each day you read.
