Choose the appropriate 5 or 6 week session for your child. Registration must be made through the Children's Department, in-person or over the phone. On-line registration is not available.

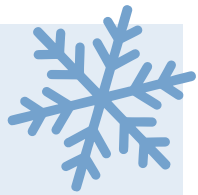
