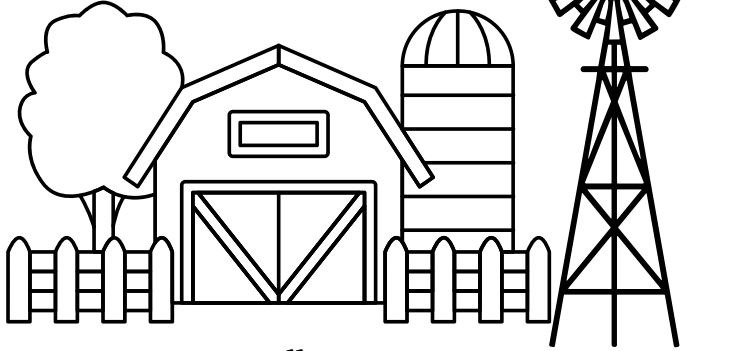


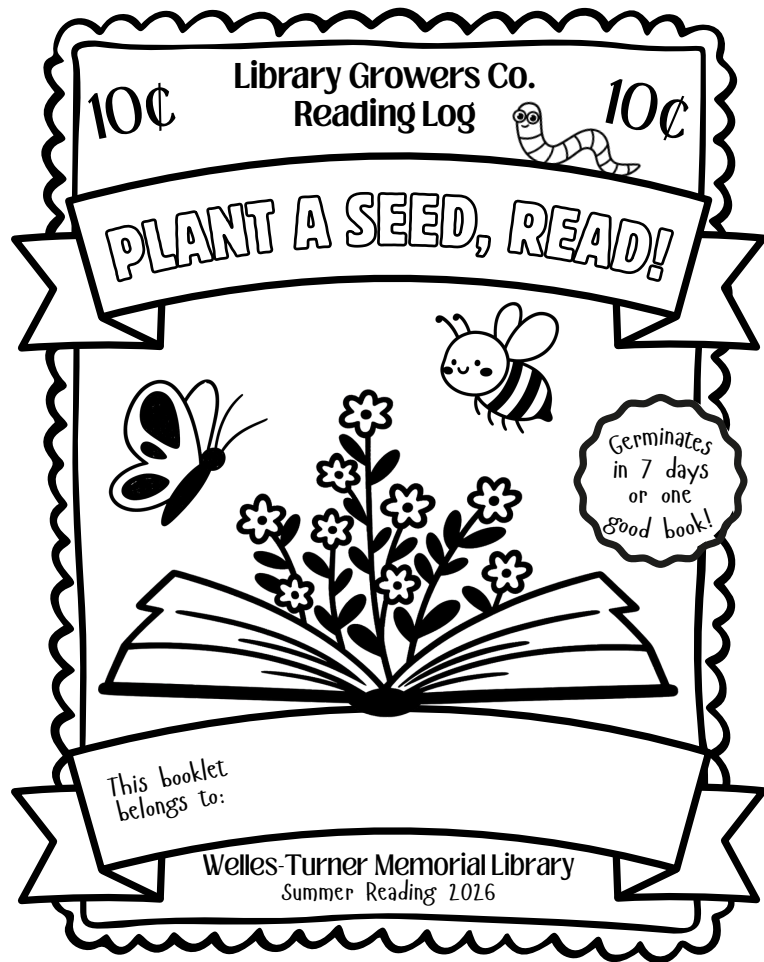
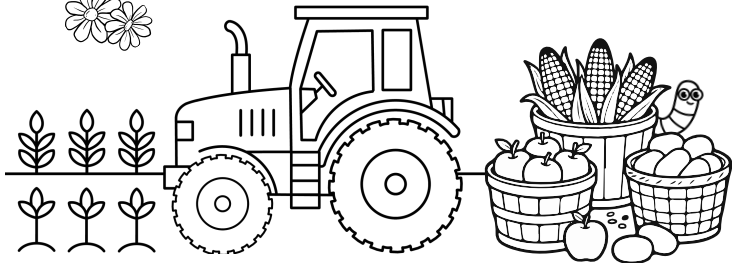

Bring your Reading Calendar to the Children's Department to register and receive your reward. The first reward is available on **June 29th**.

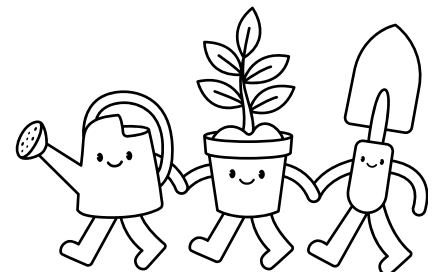
When you finish reading a book, add it to your reading log in the back of the Reading Calendar. You may also choose your own way to record your books.

Summer is a season of growing, and there is no better place than the library. Students entering grades K-6 and children ages 2 to 5 years are invited to join the **Plant a Seed, Read Summer Reading Club** which begins on **June 22nd**.

Read on your own, or have someone read to you, for about 20 minutes per day. Summer is a time for kids to read for **FUN!** For this reason, we focus on interest level instead of reading level. All types of books are encouraged, including e-books and audio books.

Find the page for the current week and color the item marked with today's date. For example, if you read on Tuesday, June 23, turn to the page for **Week One**. Find the item labeled 6/23 and color it in.



Each day that you do some reading color in the item for that date. Once you have colored 7 items, you are ready to receive your t-shirt. You do not have to read all 7 days each week. (However, it will be awesome if you do!) The days can span two or more weeks.

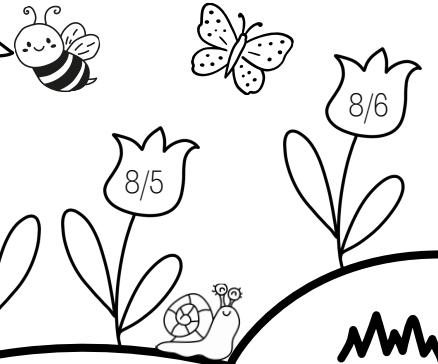

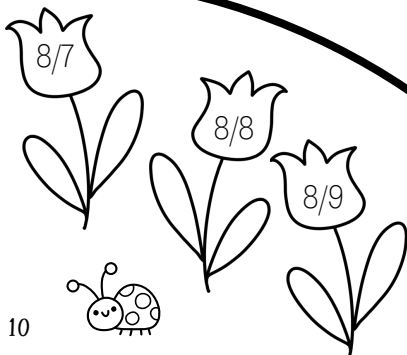

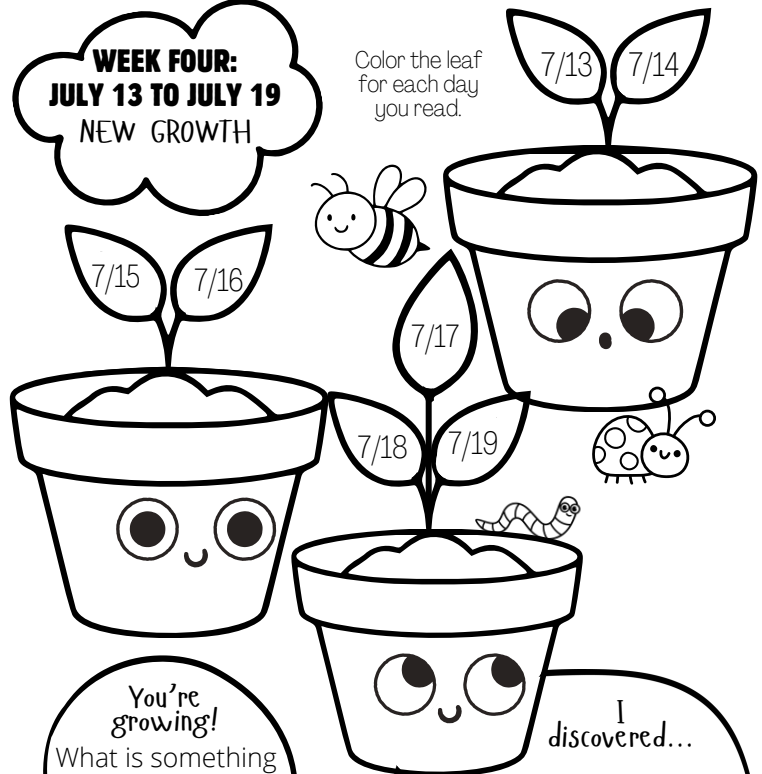

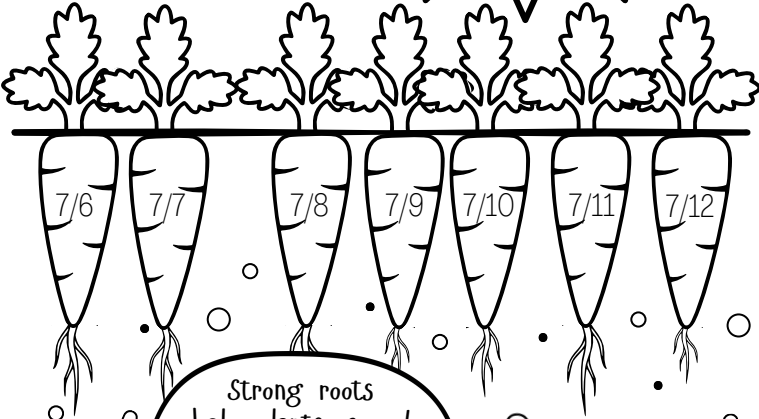

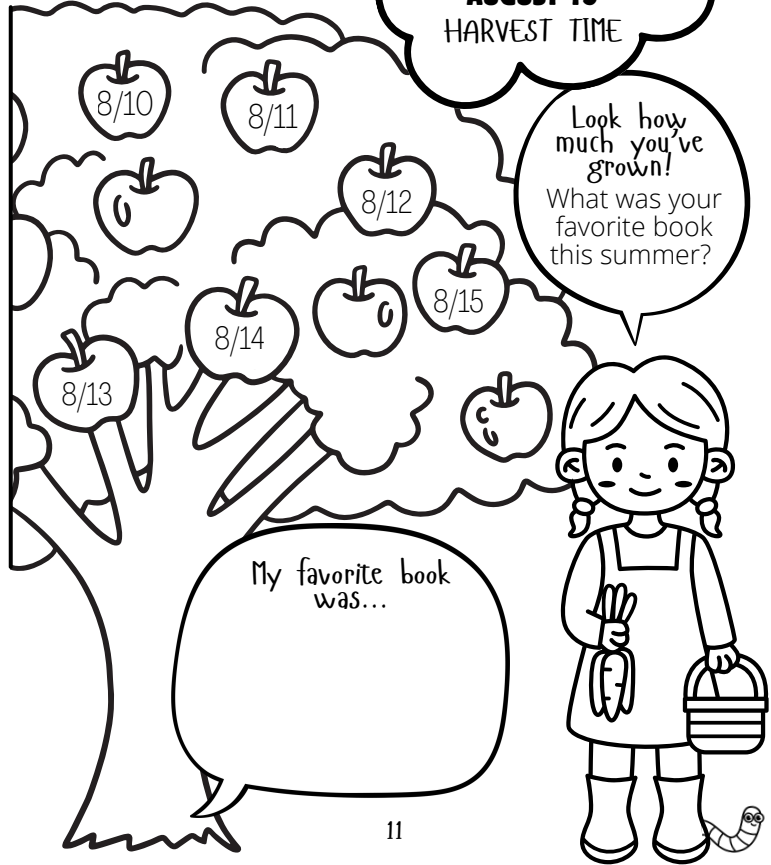

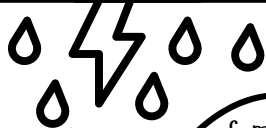
