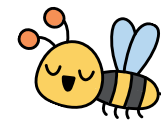

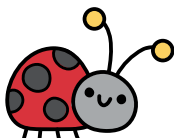
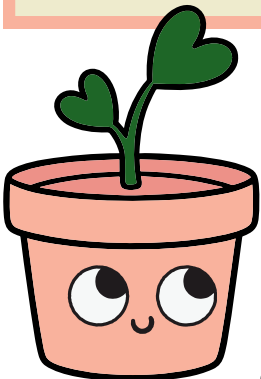
## Mother Goose

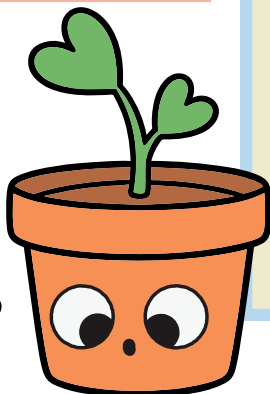
